Whakapuakitanga



HE KUPU WHAKAMIHI

E Te Māngai e Ngā Anahera pono e Te Tokotoru Tapu, kia tatū mai anō koutou ki waenganui i tēnei whakamoemiti o mātou. Hei tātari i ngā kupu katoa, e whakapuakina ana e mātou, i roto i to koutou kororiatanga. Ko koutou nei hoki te tūmatanga me te whakaotinga mai o a mātou e tūmanako atu nei i roto i tō koutou kororiatanga, ko te Māngai hei tautoko mai, āianei ake nei ĀE.

Koutou rā kua ngaro atu i te tirohanga kanohi, koutou rā e ngā pakeke, koutou rā i nōhia ngā pae kōrero me ngā pāe karanga, i tiaki mai i te ahikā o tēnā marae, o tēnā marae. Koutou hoki e ngā mate-tārūrū nui o te wā, whārikihia mai rā, kia mihia, kia tangihia, kia poroporoakihia e tātau. Moe mai rā koutou i te pō tē kitea, tē whakaarahia ake anō. Koutou mā ki a koutou. Tātau rā ngā waihotanga ki a tātau. Tēnā rā tātau katoa.

Kai taku whare e whakaruruhau nei i a au, Te Whare Wānanga o Awanuiārangi, kai taku pouārahi, Kairangi Agnes McFarland, kai aku pouako Kairangi Paul Kayes hoki, aku hoa ākonga hoki me kore ake koutou hai rarawhi, hai morimori i te wā o te piere nuku, o te uaua nā, o te mārōro. Kia hoki ake rā ki te kura nei me tā tātau pepeha ‘*Rukuhia te mātauranga ki tōna hōhonutanga me tōna whānuitanga. Whakakiia ngā kete a ngā uri o Awanuiārangi me te iwi Māori whānui ki ngā taonga tuku iho, ki te hōhonutanga me te whānuitanga o te mātauranga kia tū tangata ai rātou i ngā rā e tū mai nei.*’ Hai aha? Hai painga mōku, otirā mō taku whānau, mō taku hapū, mō taku iwi.

Nau mai haere mai rā ki te karanga a Te Ara o Tāwhaki!¹

Piki ake kake ake ki te toi huarewa, Te Ara o Tāwhaki e tū nei i waenganui i ū tātau marae kāinga, i raro i te maru o Ōtātara pā tūwatawata, Hikurangi maunga whakahī, i te taha o Tūtaekurī e haruru ake rā. Kai taku āhuru mōwai Tāwhaki, kai taku koroua whare, koe i manaaki mai i a au i roto i ngā tau e mihi kau nā. Nei rā hoki te mihi ki taku rangatira ki a Pareputiputi Nuku mōna i whakapau werawera ki te ārahi mai i a au, ehara noa hoki i te rangatira, i roto i ngā tātai whakapapa ka noho tuakana, taina māua ki a māua heke mai ana māua i a Te Hapuku. Ahakoa rā, ko ia ki te ārataki mai i a au, te whakawātea mai hoki i a au ki te whai i ngā tapuwae a kui mā, a koro mā otirā ki aku hoa mahi me aku ākonga kai Te Aho a Māui (EIT Hawke's Bay) o te nāianei me te āpōpō. Mīharo ake nei me te māha, te tau o taku ngākau ka ora te reo puipuiaki nei i a koutou e whai nei i te reo Māori hai reo kōrero i ū koutou kāinga huri noa.

Ka rere noa te kupu aumihi ki taku iwi o Ngāti Kahungunu Iwi Kaporeihana me te takoha i homai ki a au. Mokori anō a mihi ka rere. Hai tā Materoa Haenga i te tau 2005, Tāwhati te reo, mā wai te marae e taurima? Nā reira kai mua tēnā i aku whakaaro i a au e whakaako ana i aku ākonga e whai nei i te tohu paetahi Te Whakangungutanga Ki Ngā Tāiro A Kupe - Bachelor Of Arts (Māori) a Te Aho a Māui. I te tau 2011, ka taumauhia a Kahungunu ki Te Tairāwhiti, Horouta waka, Takitimu – Kia kotahi te hoe!² Te Whatukura, e ngā hoa mauroa e hika mā! Tēnā tātau e nanaiore ake nei i te mātauranga hai painga mō ū tātau kāinga o konei, o konā, o koraka rā anō rā. E mihi ana, e mihi ana, e kore e mutu te mihi. He

whakaripiripi kōhatu noa iho i ngā wai o Te Wairoa, he iti engari he iti nā te aroha ki aku iwi o Ngāti Kahungunu whānui me Rongomaiwahine.

Kai taku tokatū-moana Mum, ko koe tēnā pō noa te ao te kaupare ake i ngā ngaru nui o Tamatea! Nō mai mai ērā āhua ūhou o te manaaki, o te kōrero hāngai e Mum, nāhau mātau tokorima i whakapakeke, i whakatangata, i whakahau kia whai ake mātau i ū mātau ake wawata, moemoeā oti noa! Ko tō mātau aroha hōhonu, aroha teitei, aroha ake nei ki a koe Mum, he mutunga kore.

Kāti hā e te tau, taku hoa pūmau. Me kore ake koe hai tiaki mai i a au me tō kaha whakapono mai, i te wā kāretahi he whakapono i roto i a au. Taku pakihīwi kaha. Otirā tāua me tā tāua poai. Kāti tonu kia tae mai ia ki a tāua, rua tekau mā tahi tau i mua rā. He mea homai e Ihoa. Taku tau pūmau. Tō tāua whakawhitinga mai o te rā. Whakarongo Ake Ki Te Reo

1.0 He Kupu Whakataki

E ai ki tētahi a ū mātau koroua ki a Peka Ngahau, ki a Ted (Teri) Peka, ka tae mai Te Matua Tangata a Te Kooti Rikirangi ki te pā o Ngāmotu, ā, moe ana te pō. Matika rawa ake ka mihi a iwi manaaki mai i a ia, ā, ka poropitihia e ia ‘ka mau tō whakapapa ki te upoko hai karauna’ i ērā kupu poropiti āna kai te tāhūhū o tō mātau whare ngā marae maha e tū ana i ngā tahataha o Te Wairoa awa. Me kore ake a Sandy Adsett, uri nō Te Huki, tungāne ki a Te Rauhina te ringa toi. Nāna i whakarākei te tāhūhū ki ngā kōrero, ki ngā whakapapa mō ngā marae toru tekau mā toru, tīmata mai ana i ngā maunga o Whakapūnake me Panekire heke iho ki te ngutu awa o Te Wairoa.

I a au e tamariki ana, ia Rātapu, haere ai mātau ki te marae. E iwa tau taku pakeke i tērā wā, he tākaro te mahi, he haka, he waiata hoki te mahi. Muia ana te marae i tērā wā, muia ana e ngā pakeke, e ngā mātua, e ngā kōka i runga i te whakaaro kotahi o tētahi o aku tungāne o Tāmati Tuhura me te moemoeā ūna mō tō māua kuia mō Pahemata Ānaru. Nāna ko te whakatinanatanga mai o tō mātau wharenui, to mātau whare tipuna a Te Rauhina. E rua ngā ingoa kārangaranga mō tēnei kāinga. Ko Ngamotu tētahi ingoa, ā, ko Kihitu hoki tētahi ingoa. Ko tō mātau whare tipuna kai Ngamotu. He poraka whenua a Ngamotu āhua rima mineti mā runga motukā mai i Te Wairoa. Ko Kihitu tētahi pātiki e anga atu ai ki te marae. He rori pūehuehu, he rori kōpikopiko e tae atu ai ki Ngamotu, ki Kihitu.

Nā reira, ko te kaupapa nui i tērā wā, ko te ako waiata e pā ana ki a mātau anō, me te pōhiri i ngā manuhiri ka takahia mai ngā rori ki tō mātau marae, kia kite ai rātau i ngā mahi tukutuku, i ngā mahi kōwhaiwhai. He kohinga waiata, he hokinga mahara ki te wā i a kauheke mā, ki tētahi wā e ora pai ana te pae kōrero me te pae karanga, e mumura mai ana tō mātau hapū. Ko ngā tuhinga kōrero kai roto, he hoki whakamuri te titiro ki ngā tau waru tekau me ngā momo waiata i titoa mai e aku pakeke. Ko Whakarongo ake ki te reo tētahi o aua waiata rā. Koinei tētahi o ngā waiata e toru ka āta tātarihia e au. I tīkina atu ai koirā hai ingoa mō taku kaupapa rangahau, nā kai

roto i ngā kupu iti nei te nui o ūnā āhuatanga. Te ngāwari noa iho o ngā waiata i titoa i tērā wā.

Me he kaahu ka hoka atu au ki runga o Huianui, whakararo te titiro ki te wai tipua o ngā mātua tīpuna, arā, ki Te Wairoa Hōpūpū Hōnengenenge Mātangirau e tere ake rā, te wai i ū mai ai a Tākitimu ki uta. Tau ake rā te noho ki te mahau o taku whare tipuna, Te Rauhina wahine kōrero āio a Tapuwae te papa kāinga o Kaahu hapū, Kaahu kaitiaki.

Kāti ake, anikā a Nō Wai Te Reo hai wāhi ake i ēnei tuhinga āku, he mea tito e taku kuia, e Tuhe Smith nee Tamihana.

Nā ēnei āhuatanga katoa i tau ai ko taku kaupapa, he mea whakaora, he mea whakahou hoki i ngā kōrero mā roto mai i ngā waiata. Ngā waiata i ahu mai i ngā hapu o Ngāmotu, te pā o Te Rauhina.

1.1 Tātai Kōrero

Ko te hua o ēnei kohinga kōrero, ka whakahokia atu ki taku hapū o Kaahu tonu me taku marae o Te Rauhina, he ngākau whiwhita, he hiahia nōku ki te rangahau i ngā waiata i titoa ai e aku pakeke i ngā rā o ngā tau 70, 80 hoki. Hai koha hoki ki taku reo Māori nāna ahau i tiaki, nāna ahau i tū tangata i te ao nei. Ehara hoki rā ēnei waiata i te waiata mōteatea, he waiata pōhiri kē. Heoi anō, hai whakaara ake i ngā waiata kua roa kē e noho ana ki rō pukapuka, kia ora tonu ai mā ngā tuhangā, mā ngā mokopuna kāre anō kia whānau mai ki tēnei ao, ka tahi, ka rua, kia āta tātarihia ngā āhuatanga reo, ngā nuka reo, te toi o te kupu tae noa ki te tatangi o te reo mō te tūpono he kupu ake, he mita, he tatangi ake i a kauheke mā.

Mai i te wā i a kauheke mā tae noa mai ki tēnei rā, he kōhangā haka tō mātau i tō mātau marae. He mea āta poipoi, āta opeope hoki kia ora tonu, haere ake nei. 40 neke atu ki te 72 tau ngā pakeke o ngā kaiuru, ko rātau katoa i tipu ake i runga i te marae o Te Rauhina. Ko Te Wairoa tētahi taone iti noa iho nei. Ko te rohenga e kīa nei mai i Paritū ki Tūrakirae. Heoi anō ka whakahaerehia tēnei kaupapa rangahau. Nikā kai raro iho nei he kōrero mō tēnei kāinga iti nei.

1.2 Ko ngā whainga matua o tēnei kaupapa rangahau:

Ko ngā whāinga matua o tēnei kaupapa rangahau, he āta kohikohi i ngā kōrero, i ngā hītoria kai ngā kaiuru e mau ana. Ko ngā mahara pai kai a rātau e mau tonu ana mō tēnā waiata, mō tēnā kaitito. Tuatahi, he rapa, he tūhura i ngā kōrero e pā ana ki ngā hua o te kapa haka ki te hapū, ki te pā o Te Rauhina. Tuarua, he kohikohi i ngā kōrero e pā ana ki ngā pou reo o te hapū. Tuatoru, he arotake i ngā āhuatanga e pā ana ki te reo o Te Rauhina i roto i ngā waiata, me te huarahi whakaako i aua waiata rā hai kura kōrero mō tō mātau marae.

1.3 Ngā pātai rangahau

Ko te tino whāinga whānui o tēnei rangahau he whakatakoto kōrero he titiro ki ngā kaitito o tō mātau hapū, marae i ngā tau 80 me ngā waiata i titoa e rātau mō tō mātau marae, hapū anō hoki.

E tutuki ai tēnei kaupapa rangahau i runga ake nei, e whai ake nei ko ngā pātai.

Pātai tuatahi: He aha ngā hua o te kapa haka ki te hapū, ki te pā o Te Rauhina?

Pātai tuarua: He aha ngā hua o tēnei rangahau mō ngā whakatipuranga o te wā heke?

Pātai tuatoru: He aha ū whakaaro mō tēnei kaupapa rangahau?

1.3.1 Te Hiranga

He maha ngā pūtake me te hiranga o tēnei kaupapa rangahau. Tuatahi, kāre anō tētahi rangahau pēnei te momo kia puta i tō mātau hapū, i tō mātau marae. Mō a

mātau waiata i waiatangia i ērā rā rā. Tuarua, kāre anō hoki kia puta tētahi pūrongo mō te āhua ki te reo i tērā wā.

1.4 Tirohanga Whānui

Ko te tirohanga whānui o taku kaupapa rangahau kia pukapukahia ngā kōrero, ngā waiata o aku pakeke o ērā rā, nō reira e whai ana ahau i te huarahi rangahau e pā ana ki te Kaupapa Māori, Mātauranga Māori, Mātauranga-ā-Iwi. He mea matua kia whakahaerehia te rangahau ki ngā huarahi kaupapa Māori, ko Smith kai te taunaki i tēnei ariā, “by Māori, for Māori, with Māori.” He mea matua kia matapopore i te mana o te whānau, kua kīa hoki e Smith “the participation of Māori, in the entire research process is essential for the confidence of whānau, hapū and iwi in research is to be recovered.” (Smith, 1999)

Hai whakatauira ake. E ai ki a Lee-Morgan e pēnei ana ko te pūrākau he rangahau kaupapa Māori. (McFarland, A. & Matthews, N. (eds) 2017 wh.55).

Ka hoki anō ki te ao Māori hei ārahi i ngā mahi rangahau mana motuhake Māori. Taketake iho ko tōna tūāpapa he mea hanga ki ngā mātāpono Māori hai tāmi, hei whakahihiri, hei whakapanoni hoki i te toiora o te tangata.

Ko tā te kaupapa rangahau Māori “He whakahoki mai i ētahi mātauranga ki a tātou” (L.T.Smith, 1999, wh.183) ki te whakamahere, whakahaere, whakamahi, arotake me te whakahoki i ngā whāinga ahurea o te rangahau ki te hunga e tika ana, mō te hunga e tika ana, mā te hunga e tika ana, arā, mā ngā uri Māori. Ko te pūrākau he kaupapa rangahau (Lee, 2005).

Kāti! Ka tāpirihia atu anō ngā whakatakotoranga kōrero a Ngata hai tautoko ake i ngā kōrero a Lee-Morgan:

Heoi ko ngā tino take o ngā kōrero nei he tikanga hei ārahi, hei manaaki i te noho o te Māori. Ka mutu he uaua ake i ētahi wā te wehe i te mahi a te tipua i tērā a te tangata. (McFarland, A. & Matthews, N. (eds) 2017 wh.29).

I roto hoki i tēnei tuhinga roa e whakaaro ana ahau ki te whai i te huarahi raraunga kounga me te huarahi raraunga tatau ki te whakautu i ngā pātai. Nō te mea, he hua nui tō te noho kanohi ki te kanohi, pakihwi ki te pakihwi, matapakihia ai ngā kōrero.

Hai whakatauira ake ko ngā kōrero a (Skerrett, 2017) e kīia ana

E rua ngā rangahau matua kua horapa whānuitia; ko tētahi he raraunga kounga;³ ko tētahi he raraunga tatau.⁴ Kei te taupatupatu tonu ngā aronga o ia kaupapa rā. Ka toko ake te pātai, ko tēhea te mātāmua, ko tēhea te mātāmuri o ēnei momo rangahau? Kia kīia ai i te mutunga iho he mātauranga tūturu ake nei. Ahakoa aua taupatupatu, taukumekume me whakaaro nui tātou ki ngā taha e rua. Me whai whakaaro hoki ki ngā iwi taketake o te ao, tae rawa mai ki tō tātou ake iwi Māori. Kia pātaitia te pātai, kōhea te ara tika, te ara pono mā tātou? Ko te taha kounga? Ko te taha tatau? He huarahi kē atu rānei? Kia titia ērā pātai ki tētahi kokonga o te ngākau, kia aro tātou ki tā te Māori titiro ki tēnei mea te mātauranga. (McFarland, A. & Matthews, N. (eds) 2017 wh.103.

Ko te mahi o te kairangahau kia whiriwhirihiā tētahi huarahi e tika ana mō tō ake kaupapa me ngā kaiuru noki. Whiriwhirihiā te huarahi e pai rawa ana mō tō ake kaupapa. He rerekē ki tēnā, ki tēnā kaupapa, nā, āta whakaarohia mō te kōrero e

1.4.2 Pātai tuarua - Ko wai mā ngā pou reo i ārahi i te hapū?

Ko ngā kōrero tuku iho tētahi wāhangā nui ki tā te Māori rangahau kōrero... Hai tā McFarland (2018)

Kia mārama ki te tuku i ngā kōrero ki tēnā, ki tēnā papareanga, ki tēnā whakatipuranga whakahukahuka i ngā kōrero mai i tō kete whakawaitara. Ko wētahi tāngata he matapiko ki te tuku kōrero, ka mate atu me a rātau kōrero ehara nei nā rātau aua kōrero rā. Nā te mea nā tētahi kē noa atu i hoatu aua kōrero rā. Kua noho te tangata rā pupuri ai i aua kōrero hai whakamana i a ia. Me whakaaro nui te kairangahau, mehemea i tākohatia ngā kōrero mō tō kaupapa rangahau e wētahi atu ki a koe ko tō mahi he tuku i aua māramatanga, i aua mōhiotanga ki tētahi kē noa atu kia matatau ai te kaihopu i aua mātauranga tuku iho, kōrero tuku iho rānei. McFarland, A. & Matthews, N.(eds) 2017 wh.22).

1.4.3 Pātai tuatoru - He aha ngā mahara e pā ana ki ngā whakamārama o ngā waiata?

Mā te rangi waitī, wainene, rōreka e pupū ake ai a kare-ā-roto rāua ko raumahara me te āhua ki te kupu e whakaawe ake i a aroha, i a harakoa i a wairua āio. Mā te rangi me te kupu o te waiata e tino titi ki te ngākau, ki te mahara hoki o te tangata. He momo! Haami, B. 2013 (wh.193).

'Hearing these waiata sung conjures up feelings for tōku ipukarea (my tribal homeland). They transport me home to Tokomaru Bay to a myriad of memories from my childhood and adolescence where these waiata were performed by Ngoi and her peers, often appearing from the kitchen wearing aprons and head scarfs, with mokopuna clutching at their knees. Ka'ai, T. 2013 (wh.219).

1.5 Tirohanga whānui mō te tuhinga whakapae

Ūpoko Tuatahi - Whakarongo Ake Ki Te Reo

Ūpoko Tuarua – E Te Iwi! Takahia Mai Ngā Rori E

Ko te Ūpoko Tuarua, he āta wherawhera i ngā tuhinga mātātuhi e pā ana ki taku kaupapa rangahau. Ka pānui au i ngā kōrero a tēnā, a tēna me kore noa e kitea he hua hai taunaki i te taha waiata, te taha wetewete reo hoki. Ka mātaihia ngā titonga a aku pakeke, ā, ka whārikihia ngā kōrero nā ngā kaiuru i homai.

Ūpoko Tuatoru – Ko Wai Te Koruru Kai Runga Taku Whare Tipuna?⁵

Ko te Ūpoko Tuatoru, he wānanga i ētahi pou taraāwaho me ngā huarahi rangahau e pā ana, e hono ana ki taku kaupapa rangahau. Arā, ko taku huarahi rangahau ko te raraunga kounga. I roto i tēnei upoko, ka whakaaturia te huarahi rangahau, ā, ka rangahaua, ka waihangahia hoki tāku ake pou taraāwaho ka whakamahia e au hai whakautu i aku patapatai ka whakatakotohia ake hai tāwharau hoki i taku kaupapa.

Ūpoko Tuawhā - Ko Te Wahine Āio Nei A Te Rauhina!

Ko te ngako o taku tuhingaroa ka whakatakotohia ki te Ūpoko Tuawhā, he whaiwhai, he kohikohi, he hopu i ngā kōrero a ngā kaiuru kua uia e au mō tēnei rangahau. Hai whakatauira ake ko ngā uiuinga tāngata; ngā patapātai; tatauranga;

Ūpoko Tuarima – Kua Pae Mai Au Ki Te Āhuru Mōwai O Taku Tipuna Whare

Ko te ūpoko Tuarima, he āta whakarāpopoto i ngā kōrero kua whakatakotohia i roto o ia upoko kōrero. He whakatakoto hoki i ngā hua ka puta i roto i tēnei rangahau me te titiro tawhiti mō ngā whakatipuranga o taku hapū o Kaahu e hāro ake nei arā, ki te tirohangā anamata.

1.6 He Whakarāpopotanga

Me kī rā, kua whakatakotoria e au ngā kōrero whakamahuki mō taku kaupapa rangahau. Ko te manako nui e mārakerake ana te āta mātai ake i te ia o taku kōrero. I roto i tēnei ūpoko kōrero e whai ake nei, te ūpoko tuarua, ka whakapuakina he kupu whakataki mō tēnei kaupapa rangahau, he āta titiro ki ngā tuhinga mātātuhi e pā ana ki taku kaupapa rangahau. Ngā pukapuka hai pānuitanga māku, hai taunaki hoki i taku kaupapa. tae atu hoki ki ngā pukapuka koretā hai tautoko i taku kaupapa rangahau.

2.0 He Kupu Whakataki

Ko tā te ūpoko i mua, he whakapuaki i taku manawanui ki taku kāinga tipu, ki taku hapū o Kaahu, ki taku marae o Te Rauhina, ki aku kauheke kaumātua o tērā wā me aku pātai e pā ana ki taku kaupapa e kīa ana ‘Ko te reo o Te Rauhina hai kura kōrero mō ngā whakareanga’.

Hai tēnei o ngā ūpoko he āta tātari i ngā mātātuhi me ngā momo tuhinga e hāngai ana ki taku kaupapa rangahau te mahi.

Ko Jenny Bol Jun Lee-Morgan – Pūrākau: Hei kaupapa rangahau mana motuhake Māori!

Ka kimi noa, ka rapa noa ngā pukapuka kua oti kē te tuhi mō ngā kōrero pūrākau. Ki konei ka tīkina atu ngā kōrero a Jenny Bol Jun Lee-Morgan (2017), hai whakawhānui atu i tēnei ariā, “Ko tā te pūrākau he whakapātaritari i te hinengaro o te hunga whakarongo, he whakaaweawe i te ngākau hihiiko o te hunga whakapono, he kukume i ngā kare-ā-roto, hai wherawhera i ngā kura huna o te kōrero kia puta ai he māramatanga he mātauranga me ngā tini akoranga o roto”.

(Lee-Morgan, J. 2017, wh.48)

E ai ki ngā whakaaro o mai anō, hai tohutohu, hai whakatūpato, hai kawe hoki i ngā mamae, ngā pōuri, ngā tūmanako, ngā wawata, ngā mātauranga tēnei mea te pūrākau, kua whakaarahia ake e tēnā kaikōrero, e tēnā kaituhi rānei. ‘Ko tā te pūrākau he toro ki ngā kurutongarewa o te whakapapa, o ngā whakataukī, o te mōteatea, o te haka, o

te whaikōrero, o te whakairo, o te peita me ngā tohu hoki o te taiao hei whenu i ngā whītau o te pūrākau.' ‘Hai whakapātaritari i te hinengaro, hai whakaaweawe i te ngākau hihi, hai kukume i ngā kare-ā-roto, hai wherawhera i ngā kura huna o te kōrero te mahi a te pūrākau e ai ki te wahine nāna nei te kōrero nei a Jenny.’

Hai tā (Mita, 2000) hoki, ‘ki te Māori he pono, he tika te pūrākau, he tūmomo taunakitanga, ko te pūrākau hei tūāpapa hoki ki te ao Māori e whakaatu mai ai me pēhea tātou e ora ai i tēnei ao.’

Heoi anō, nō te taenga mai o ngā kairangahau Pākehā me tā rātau ake titiro ki te ao i noho ai ō tātau tīpuna, he puruhēti, he rūpahu, he tipatipa, he kōrero parau noa te pūrākau. ‘Ki a rātou ko te pūrākau he kōrero noa iho, ehara hoki i te kōrero hōhonu, i te kōrero pono rānei. He kūware nō ngā iwi taketake o te ao.(Smith, L., 1999).

Waihoki nā rātau hoki ngā pūrākau o ngā tūpuna i tāhae, i raweke, nā tērā hoki i takahia ngā pūrākau, otirā ngā mātauranga katoa o ngā iwi katoa (Mikaere, 1995). Ko ngā kōrero pēnei i ngā whakapapa, ngā mōteatea, ngā whakataukī, i whakataurekarekahia.

Ahakoa ngā tāmitanga a ngā Pākehā, ā-hāhi, ā-kura, ā-ture, ā-rangahau hoki kai te ora tonu ā tātau kōrero tuku, ā tātau pūrākau. I mīharo ahau ki ngā kōrero a Amster Reedy, 1993 e kī ana, nō te taenga mai o ngā mihinare ki Aotearoa, i tere mau i ō tātau tīpuna ngā pūkenga tuhituhi me te pānui, ka mutu, ka tahuri ake rātau ki te whakapukapuka i ā rātau pūrākau. Me te papai hoki o tā rātau i tuhi ai, tohunga tonu atu! Koinei tētahi o ngā kōrero i rongo ahau i tētahi o ngā kauhau a Pou Temara i te tau 2007. Ka mea mai ia, ka tae atu te tini me te mano, ahakoa Māori mai, Pākehā

mai, ahakoa reo Māori, reo Pākehā rānei ki te whare pāremata ki te whakarongo ki ngā pūkōrero o tērā wā. Rawe kē nei ēnei kōrero ki a au, koirā tāku e whai nei kia rite ki a rātau mā.

Mō te taha ki te kore hua, ko ngā kōrero pea i mahue. Tuarua, ko ētahi o ngā kōrero kāre au i te mōhio, kāre hoki i kitea i te papakupu. Atu i tēnā, he rawe tēnei kōrero ki a au mō te taha hoki ki āku ake mahi rangahau. Kāre au e rata ki te kimi hapa, heoi anō. Ko tā Tākuta Wayne Ngata – Te Kawa o Te Kōrero(2017)

Ko te ngako tonu o te kōrero a Wayne Ngata, arā, kua whakaritea te ara rangahau ki tētahi marae. Ko tōna whare te tuhingaroa e tuhingia ana. Ko te pōhiri, te whakaeke, te whakatata atu e kīia ai he whare kōrero, ko ngā pou ngā upoko tonu o te tuhinga, ka tomokia te whare ka whakataua, ka mihiā, ka huri ngā kōrero i te whatitoka, te taraiti whakawhiti atu rā ki te taranui me ngā kōrero, ngā take a tēnā pou, a tēnā poukōrero. Ka tipu mai aua kōrero i te hirikapo, i te ngākau, i te hinengaro hoki ka puta ki te whaiao hai whakarongo mā te taringa o te tangata. He wā anō kia kōpani ake i te kōrero mā tētahi anō ā tōna wā e tiki mai. Ko ēnei momo whakahuihui te tino kaupapa o te whare kōrero.

Ko tētahi anō o ana kōrero, ka kōrero ia mō te tapa ingoa, o te tiki atu i te ingoa o tētahi whare, maunga, awa, aha atu rānei o whenua kē, o wāhi kē rānei hai whakamana i tētahi mea. Pēnei i te maunga Hikurangi, te whare tipuna nei a Ruawharo, te whare tipuna nei a Takitimu me ngā ingoa i ahu mai i tawhiti. Arā ko Te Mahia Mai Tawhiti, Whāngārā Mai Tawhiti, Opotiki Mai Tawhiti. “Ehara i te tikanga hou, nō mai anō tēnei āhuatanga te kapo ake i tētahi ingoa whaimana hei ingoa anō ka huaina ki tōu nā wāhi, whare, tangata tonu nei, ā i pērā anō ki konei.

E ai hoki ki a Mark Kōpua o Ngāti Kurī, hapū o Te Aitanga a Hauiti, Uawa. Ko te whare kōrero, he tikanga, he wāhi whakawhitiwhiti kōrero rānei, ā, he whaiwhai kōrero i roto i te whare tōna rite. Kia whānui rawa ngā momo whakawhitiwhitinga i waenganui i te hunga kōrero me te hunga whakarongo, i te kaiako me te ākonga, i te ākonga me te ākonga anō. Mārakerake te kite atu i te whakaraupapatanga o tēnei mea te rangahau i roto i ngā kōrero. Ko te whakatau i te kawa o te kōrero me ngā tikanga hoki o te kōrero. (Ngata, W. 2017. wh.29).

Ko ngā painga o roto i te kōrero nei, ko ngā tauira rangahau kua whakatakotoria ki roto hai whai māku i te ao rangahau nei. He māmā noa iho, e mārama ana hoki te taitara o ia upoko, ka mutu e hāngai ana hoki ki te āhua o te pōhiri, ngā āhuatanga whakahaere i runga i te marae, ngā whakawhitiwhiti kōrero ka rangona, tae noa hoki ki te hākari. Ko tētahi o ngā kore hua, ko ngā kōrero whakapapa o tangata kē atu hai tirohanga mā te motu.

Ko tā Tākuta Darryn Joseph (Kīhono: Whakamaua ki Tō Reo Wānanga) whāinga nui a tēnei o ngā kaupapa kōrero, ko te rourou kīhono. Ka Kimihia, ka rangahaua, ka rapā te kupu kīhono nei engari auare ake, tahi ka wetewetehia, ka taka te kapa. Ko ngā kupu, kī hai hono i tētahi kōrero ki tētahi rā. Kua whakatakotoria ngā āheinga reo ki tētahi taha, ngā whakapākehātanga ki waenganui me ngā tauira reo ki te taha katau. Ko ngā tīmatanga kōrero, ko ētahi kōrero hai tohu i te wā, ko te whakaraupapa whakaaro, ko te whakatauria, ko te rautanga atu o te whakatauāki, ko ngā kōrero taunaki, ko ngā āpitihanga, ko te tūhonohono i ngā kōrero, ko ngā tauira me pēhea te whakahē i ngā kōrero, ko te whakataurite me te whakatairite whakaaro, ko te whai whakaaro, ko te taunga tika, te arotake, te whakaū kaupapa, te āpiti whakaaro, te whakatau whakaaro, me ngā kōrero whakakapi.

Ka mau te wehi i te nui o ngā kīhono nei mō ngā momo āhuatanga tauira katoa. E taunaki ana au i te kōrero e mea ana he āwina tēnei mā te ākonga me te kaiako anō hoki mō te mahi tuhituhi. Ahakoa reo mātauranga, tuhinga roa, tuhinga poto, pepa, atikara, tuhinga paetahi, tuhinga paerua, tuhinga kairangi rānei. E tino whai hua ana ngā kīhono nei.

Hai tā Bowker, (2007) ki te whai hua ēnei tū kīanga, kai runga noa atu, ki te kore me waiho ki rāhaki. Ko te kaupapa matua o tēnei atikara, he homai whakaaro, he homai āwhina mō te tuhi kōrero kia kore ai e toka ngā whakaaro engari kia rite ki te awa o waho e tere ake rā ki te moana. Arā kē te nui o ngā kupu kōrero hai rau atu ki ngā kōrero. Kia kotahi atu taku mihi ki te mātanga reo nei ki a Tākuta Joseph me ūna whakaaro e pā ana ki te tuhituhi kōrero. Kai whea mai!

Ko tā Ahorangi Taiarahia Black (Tūhoe Ariā Matua Kōrero)

I puta i a Hōani Te Rangiāniwaniwa Rangihau o Ngāi Tūhoe te kōrero nei i te tau 1967 ki tōna iwi: “Ē hoki ki ō maunga, ki ō awa, ki ō kōhatu, ki ō hau kia purea koe e ngā hau o Tāwhirimātea”. He mataku pea, he matapae rānei nō te koroua nei ko te taura whanaunga, te taura tangata ka motu me te uaua te whiriwhiri anō i aua taura rā o te matemateāone ki te kore e whakarite i tētahi kaupapa hai tō mai i ūna uri. Nāwai, nāwai, ā, i te tau 1971 ka ara ake ko Te Ahurei a Tūhoe hai rongoā i ērā mataku ūna. I whakatūria e ngā pakeke o Tūhoe tēnei tū hui hai kohikohi i ngā uri kia hoki atu rātau ki te whaiwhai i te reo, i ngā tikanga, i ngā waiata tawhito, i ngā kōrero tuku a tō rātau nā iwi. Nō tērā tau (2018) ka tū te hui Ahurei nei ki roto o Te Arawa. Ka whakahāngaihia ake ngā kōrero a Te Rangihau ki te taitara o tā Ahorangi Taiarahia kōrero mō te ariā matua (critical theory). Me kore ake tana whakahau hai whakarauora mai i tōna iwi, e ora tonu nei i te rā nei.

Ka āta wānangahia hoki ēnei kohinga kōrero, tuatahi ko te maioha-poroporoaki, tuarua ko te manawa wera, tuatoru ko te tauparapara me ūna āhuatanga mātauranga ake o Tūhoe taketake. Ko roto mai o ēnā, ko te ora, ko te mauri, ko te taukiri, ko te oro me te tiketike o te reo. Hai tā Ahrorangi Black e hāngai ana ēnei ki ngā ariā matua o ngā kaupapa rangahau Māori. Ka noho ko ēnei rangatira a Te Rānui Black rāua ko Te Mākarini Tēmara hai kaupapa e taea ai te whakaputa whakaaro mō te maioha-poroporoaki, tuarua ko te manawa wera, tuatoru ko te tauparapara.

Tuatahi, e mihi ana ki te wairua o ngā kōrero, ahakoa kāre au i te mōhio ki ngā koroua nei, nā te pānuitanga o ēnei kōrero, me kī, e āhua mōhio ana ki a rāua. Ki ūrāua āhua, ki ā rāua mahi ki roto i ūrāua hapū me tō rāua iwi, ki ā rāua pātere, manawa wera, haka, tauparapara. Ko te mea e tino kite ana, e tino rongo ana, ko te maurutanga o te mamae, ko te māramatanga o te pōuri. Tuarua, e mihi ana ki ngā tohutohu, ki ngā kupu akiaki, ki ngā kupu whakakipakipa i te hunga pēnei i a au nei, e whai nei i tēnei ara rangahau engari e whai ana hoki i te reo Māori hai painga mō ūku. Nōku te māngari!

Kotahi noa tāku, kua rima tekau tau a Te Āhurei a Tūhoe e whakahaerehia ana, he aha kai tua, he aha ngā kaupapa hou ka ara ake?

E ai ki a Tākuta Mere Skerrett, e rua ngā ara rangahau matua e mōhio whānuitia ana huri i te ao, arā, ko te raraunga kounga me te raraunga tatau (e titiro nei ki ngā mahi whika). Ahakoa he hua tō ngā mea e rua nei, he pai ake tētahi i tētahi rā hai tā Tākuta Mere. Mō te painga o ngā iwi taketake o te ao me tō tāua iwi Māori tonu, ko te raraunga kounga ka whai hua.

Ka kōrero anō ia mō te mātauranga Māori me tōna orokohanga mai me te rerekē hoki o te whakaaro Pākehā ki tō te whakaaro Māori. E ai ki a M. Jackson (2011), e whā ngā aronga matua, me mōhio te tangata ki a ia anō, me mōhio ia ki tōna taiao, me whānui ngā whakaaro, kaua e whāiti, ā, me mōhio hoki e anga pēhea ana tātau. E kī ana a J. Metge (2015) e rua ngā momo mātauranga, ko te tapu me te noa, he hoa haere rāua. Ko tētahi me uaua ka kitea, ko tētahi he āhua māmā ake. Heoi anō, nā te whakarīwaitanga o Aotearoa, arā te taenga mai o Tauiwi, ka raru katoa ngā tikanga o te tapu me te noa.

Ko Grosfoguel (2015) e mea ana, e rua ngā taha e hāngai ana ki te mana o te mātauranga. Ko te taha mauī te taha ngoikore, kāretahi he mana. Ko te taha katau te taha whai kaha, whai mana. Ko te taha mauī, ko tātau, ko ngā iwi taketake o te ao, he iwi mohoao. Ko tātau kai raro e putu ana, ko te taha katau, ko te iwi Pākehā kai runga noa atu. Nā ēnei kōrero ka puta i a Moana Jackson (2016) ēnei kupu e whai ake nei “The education system still continues to fail so many of our mokopuna because that’s what it was designed to do”.

He ngāwari te pānui, mārama ana hoki te whai i ngā kōrero a te kōka nei, he nui hoki ngā kōrero me ngā kupu hou tonu i tīpakohia hai āwhina, hai ārahi i a au. Me kore ake ia me tana whai atu i ngā rangahau a tēnā kairangahau o tua o tata rānei. Kua whānui taku titiro. Rawe kē nei ki a au tāna nei tiki atu i ngā whiti o ngā waiata a Tuini Moetu Haangu Ngawai, kaitito, kaiako, kaikuti hipi, kaitohutohu hoki o Ngāti Porou hai whakaū i ana kōrero whakatūpato mō ngā mahi a te Pākeha, a Hātana rānei.

2.1 Kaupapa Matua Mātātuhi

Ko te kaupapa matua o ēnei tū hui, ko te whakarauora i te reo o taku iwi. Te titiro ki ngā whakaputunga o te iwi kai ngā whare pukapuka me te pānui pukapuka hoki. Ka whakaritea e au he pou tarāwaho, ka whakahāngaihia atu ki taku kaupapa rangahau.

Ka whakaritea he tukanga rangahau, ka uia ngā kaiuru i reira i te wā i whakaakona ai ngā waiata. Ka mau hoki ngā kōrero a tēnā kaiuru, a tēnā kaiuru.

He kaupapa whakahirahira tēnei nātemea ka puta ngā kōrero i runga i ngā mātāpono o ēnei pou tarāwaho. He mea nui ēnei huarahi kia tutuki pai ai taku kaupapa rangahau.

Ko te pou tarāwaho tuarua ka āta tātarihia, ko te kaupapa rangahau Māori. He mea waihangā tēnei kaupapa e Ahorangi Linda Tuhiwai Smith, Ahorangi Hingangaroa


Smith rātau mā ko ngā kaituhi mātanga rangahau Māori. Hai tā Smith (2007) he tauira te kaupapa rangahau Māori mā te Māori, mō te Māori me te Māori hai whai atu, hai whakakotahi mai i ngā whakaaro Māori ki ētahi aria o ngā iwi taketake o te ao. Ko Leonie Pihama e tautoko ana i ngā whakaaro o te tokorua kua kōrerohia e au i mua rā. Hai tāna he taputapu, he rauemi kē te kaupapa rangahau Māori hai whakahē i tō tātau reo rangatira.

E hangai pū ana te huarahi rangahau Kaupapa Māori nātemea e tika ana kia noho tūāpapa te rangahau nei i raro i tētahi tuanui Māori e ūrite nei ngā mātāpono. Nikā e rārangi ake nei aua mātāpono e ai ki a Smith:

- Aroha ki te tangata
- Kanohi kitea
- Titiro, whakarongo, kōrero
- Manaaki
- Kia tūpato

Ko tēnei kaupapa rangahau, ka whakamahia ko te raraunga kounga. Hai tā Barnes (2002) e tautoko ana ia i te whakaaro e mea ana, ‘Qualitative methods of gathering data have been considered to be more appropriate to kaupapa Māori research because they have been viewed as more empowering for research participants.

Ko te tino pūtake o tēnei kaupapa rangahau he whai i te huarahi o te kaupapa Māori rangahau me ūna tini āhuatanga. Inā te kōrero a Cram, Pihama and Barbara (2002), Operating in a Kaupapa Māori framework necessitates a research process that affirmed Kaupapa Māori ethics. These ethics are informed by tikanga Māori and demand that negotiation with participants be undertaken (cit. in Hudson, 2005, wh.57).

E mea ana a Tā Hirini Moko Mead (2003, wh 121-122):

The pōhiri, as we can see, is a complex set of interlocking tikanga that requires hosts and visitors to engage in a series of ritual encounters to end that the tapu of visitors is reduced to a state of noa and all parties are then free to socialise and take part in whatever else follows. In a typical pōhiri the rituals of encounter may be analysed as a sequence of steps in the transformation process.



E mea ana a Nathan Matthews rāua ko Karyn Paringatai (2004, wh 108):

Haka pōhiri are the haka performed during the rituals of encounter to welcome visitors onto the marae. This type of haka varies from tribe to tribe, but often includes performances by male and female, both individually and together. It can also include the performance of other types of haka such as haka taparahi,¹³ whakatū waewae or tūtū ngārahu.¹⁴

Te whakarauora i te reo

Hai tā Tākuta Rawinia Higgins (2019) o Ngāi Tūhoe, Toihau hoki o Te Taura Whiri i Te Reo Māori ki The Spinoff¹⁵ ‘It takes one generation to lose the language, it takes three generations to restore it’.

Ka pā ēnei momo kōrero ki te nui, ki te maha o ngā kaupapa o te ao Māori. Ko te hua o ēnei kōrero nei, he matapihi ki te ao i noho ai a tūāiho mā, a tūnōhunohu mā. Kua whakarite tētahi huarahi māmā, ana ko te āta whakariterite i te wāhi e pai ai, e haumaru au hoki te kaiuru, ahakoa noho tata, noho tawhiti rānei.

3.4 Ngā Pātai

Pātai tuatahi – He aha ngā hua o te kapa haka ki te hapū, ki te pā o Te Rauhina?

Ko te uiui tētahi tukanga kua whiriwhiria hai whakautu i te pātai tuatahi. Hai tā te kuia nei a Rose Pere, (1991). Mō te kounga o te uiui, me whai tikanga, me whai whakaaro, kia mānawanawa. Me taringa areare, ka rerekē pea ō whakaaro ki ērā o te kaiuru engari hai aha mā wai. Ka mutu ana te uiui, me karakia, me whāngai hoki ki te kai.

Ko tētahi ngoikoretanga o te ui pātai ko te poto o te wā, ko te noho tawhiti pea o ētahi o ngā kaiuru, ko te whakamā pea o te kaiuru ki te kōrero.

Pātai tuarua - He aha ngā hua o tēnei rangahau mō ngā whakatipuranga o te wā heke?

Kua whakaritea he rārangī pātai hai tukanga kua whiriwhiria hai whakautu i te pātai tuarua. Bell (1997) said “questionnaires are a good and efficient way of collecting information quickly and relatively cheaply. Researchers use questionnaires to gather information by way of different questions types: verbal; open; list; category; rank; scale; quantity; and grid.”

Pātai tuatoru - He aha ōu whakaaro mō tēnei kaupapa rangahau?

3.5 He Whakarāpopotanga

Tēnei ūpoko o runga ake, i whakamāramahia ngā tukunga rangahau, ngā huarahi rangahau i whakahaerehia ai te mātai tuhinga nei. Otirā hai whakanui hoki i aku pakeke nā rātau nei ngā waiata i tito.

Ko te ūpoko e whai ake nei, he whakarāpopoto ake i ngā kaupapa matua o tēnei kaupapa.

4.0 He Kupu Whakataki

Ko te ūpoko i mua, ko ngā whakamahuki mō ngā pou taraāwaho ka whakamahia e au mō tēnei kaupapa rangahau. Kua kōrero au mō ngā pou taraāwaho e toru ka whakamahia e au ki roto i taku rangahau. Ka whakamāramahia ake e au tāku ake pou tarāwaho i waihangahia rā. Ka puta taku kaupapa ki te ao mārama nā runga i ngā pou tarāwaho ka whāia ake.

4.1 He arotake i ngā ariā matua

I te ūpoko tuatahi, ka matapakiha ngā kōrero mō taku kaupapa rangahau, ngā pātai, ko wai a wai, nō hea hoki. Ka noho mātaamua ēnei kōrero, e tika ana ka noho ki te ūpoko tuatahi hai tūāpapa, hai wāhi i ngā kōrero ka whai mai.

I te ūpoko tuarua, ka whakamāramahia ake ngā tikanga mātātuhi, ngā pukapuka kua whiria hai pānuitanga māku. Katoa ēnei pukapuka e hāngai ana ki te āhua o taku kaupapa rangahau.

I te ūpoko tuatoru, ko ngā tukunga rangahau kua mahia, he huarahi ērā e tika ana mō tēnei mātai tuhinga. Ko te tukunga rangahau Kaupapa Māori, e hāpai ana i te Māori, māna anō tana rangahau e mahi, arā, “nā te Māori, mā te Māori, ki te Māori” (Smith, n.d.) He mea matua tēnei he mea whai tikanga hai tiaki i ngā kaiuru me ngā pūrākau ka puta mō taku kaupapa rangahau.

4.2 He tīmatanga kōrero

Ko te matū o ngā kōrero e whai ake nei, ko ngā kōrero kua rangona, kua rangahaua, kua kohia e pā ana ki ngā waiata i kaha waiatahia e rātau mā i te whakatuwheratanga mai o tō mātau whare tipuna a Te Rauhina. I haere mātau ki ngā momo kaupapa whakatuwheratanga whare i tērā wā, huri i te rohe o Te Wairoa me Heretaunga hoki. Ko ngā marae, ko Te Haroto, ko Omaha, ko Mangaroa, ko Te Kapu, ko Pākōwhai. He kaihoahoa taku hoa rangatira a Tāmati

(Tom). Nāna ngā wharenu i me ngā wharekai nei i whakarite, i hanga i runga pepa. Kaua ki te whakakīkī i ōna ake pūkoro, kāo, mēnā i hiahia ngā marae ki te tuku moni, ko tā Tom me tuku ki te marae o Te Rauhina. He pērā ia.

I tōna matenga, ka whāngaihia anō ahau e tētahi o ana tamāhine, e Pahemata rāua ko Ānaru Ānaru. Ka whānau mai au i Te Arawa engari ka whakapakekehia mai rā i roto i a au anō o Ngāti Kahungunu, Te Wairoa.

Tēnā kōrero mai mō te kapa haka i runga i te marae o Te Rauhina i ōu nā rā. Ko wai mā i reira, i mua e whakaako ana i a koutou?

Kāre he kapa haka i tērā wā, kia tata rawa mai rā ki te whakatuwheratanga o Te Rauhina. Kātahi ka whakaae mai ngā kaumātua me te komiti o te marae kia tū tētahi rōpū mō te whakatuwheratanga o te wharenu. Ko ngā pakeke kai te maumahara au, ko Panapana Ngatoa nee Tamihana rātau ko Tuhe Smith nee Tamihana, ko Lena Rewi, ko Parae Christie, ko George Mihaere, ko Rua Mihaere, ko Ike Henare, ko Luke Henare, ko Puggy Henare, ko Piko Rarere, ko Ted rāua ko Maggie Peka, ko Rudolph rāua ko Te Paea Keefe nee Henare, ko Edie Kaukau, ko Maude Kaukau nee Neville, ko Hēni Kamaea Thompson, ko Temple Mihaere, ko Paea Pearse, ko Nellie Thompson, ko Tangi Haronga nee Tamihana, ko Josephine Christie nee Smith. O ēnei ingoa katoa, ko Josephine Christie e ora tonu ana, e waru tekau mā whitu tau tōna pakeke.

Ko te hunga i mua e whakaako ana i a mātau, ko Tairāwhiti Rātapu. Nā tōna pāpā, nā Ānaru Ānaru ia i tautoko. Ko ia te māhita o ngā koea o te hāhi Rātana. Ko Te Takutaimoana Te Rohe tētahi nō ngā tau 1950 ki ngā tau 1960. Nō muri mai ko Tairāwhiti o Te Wairoa nō ngā tau 1960 ki te tau 1970. Ko Ānaru Ānaru tō mātau māhita. Nō Tāngioia ia, ka moe ia ki roto o Ngāmotu.

He aha ētahi o ngā mahara e titi tonu nei ki te ngākau?

Ka waiata mātau, ka parakatihī mātau i ā mātau waiata i a mātau e mahi ana i ngā tukutuku, e peita ana i ngā pakitara, e tahitahi ana i te papa, ā, aha atu, aha atu kia mau pai i a mātau ngā kupu.

Kōrero mai mō te waiata nei a Whakarongo ake te reo. Nā wai i tito? He aha tōna momo, te waiata nei a Whakarongo ake te reo? Nō nahea i titoa ai?

Taku mahara ake, i titoa tēnei waiata e Lena Thomas rāua ko Ānaru Ānaru mō te tīma hōkī o Huianui, ka mutu he rōpū kapa haka hoki i tērā wā. Ko Tairāwhiti tētahi o ngā mema o taua tīma. Ka tono ia ki tana pāpā ki a Ānaru kia tuhia ngā kupu, kia panonihia hoki ngā kupu te whakahāngai atu ki te kaupapa o te rā, te whakatuwheratanga o tō tātau whare tipuna. Kāre au i te mōhio nō nahea i titoa ai, nō mua pea i taku whānautanga mai, e aua! Ko te nuinga o ngā whānau i reira i taua wā, i roto i ngā rārangī o te rōpū, ko ngā mokopuna a Kehu Tamihana rāua ko Tangi Apatu.

Kōrero mai mō te waiata nei a E te iwi? Nā wai i tito? He aha tōna momo, te waiata nei a E te iwi? Nō nahea i titoa ai?

Āe, nā Tangiora Mihaere anō i tito tēnei waiata mō te wā o Huianui tīma hōki. Katoa ēnei waiata i titoa i aua wā rā.

Kōrero mai mō te waiata nei a Titiro ki Whakapūnake? Nā wai i tito? He aha tōna momo, te waiata nei a Titiro Ki Whakapūnake? Nō nahea i titoa ai?

Nā John Keefe i tito tēnei waiata a tātau. E ai ki taku whanaunga a Hine Kohn, i titoa tēnei waiata mō te whakatuwheratanga o te marae o Taihoa.

Hai whakakapi ake, pārekareka katoa ki a au tērā wā. Ngā parakatihi i te marae, i te wharekai iti. Ka haere anō hoki mātau ki te marae o Taihoa parakatihi ai i te taha o te whānau o te marae o Pākōwhai i te mea rā hoki, i whakapuarehia tō rātau wharekai, wiki i mua i te whakatuwheratanga o Te Rauhina.

I roto i ū māua whakapapa he tuahine tōku kuia ki te koroua o taku karangatahi e whai ake nei. 12 tau tana pakeke i te whakatuwheratanga o tō māua tipuna whare a Te Rauhina. Ahakoa he taina nōku, pakeke ake ia i a au, i te wā o ngā whakaharatau, kaha ana mātau ki te whaiwhai pīhau i te mea ai hoki ko ia te mea mōhio ki ngā kupu me ngā ringa o ā mātau waiata. Mātau ngā mea tamariki o te kapa ka tū ki mua rawa engari ka mate ki te hoki whakamuri te titiro ki ū mātau tuākana, he kore mōhio nō mātau ki ngā ringa me ngā nekehanga. Ko Janine Hau nee Thompson tēnei, ka waiho māna ia e kōrero.

What was kapa haka like on the marae back in the time Te Rauhina was being built?

At that time, I would've been 12 years old and what I can remember is that there was no existing kapa haka or active kapa haka rōpū for Te Rauhina until the rebuild of the meeting house and that was all formed by whānau which was us. It was a new experience for a lot of us. A lot of us weren't familiar with kapa haka, but what I can confidently say was that we all loved to sing and thankfully we could all sing as well.

Who can you remember was there, and who was out the front teaching?

The whānau present at the time was all my own family, my parents and my siblings, all my tuākana, ko au te pōtiki. We had siblings of my father's side, again they whakapapa back to Te Rauhina. We also had extended whānau as well. I can remember te whānau Rātapu, te whānau Ānaru Ānaru, te whānau Pearse, te whānau Tāite, te whānau Peka, te whānau Henare, and other whānau who came to support the opening of our whare tipuna. We had some of our whānau from Taihoa marae, who were part of the kapa haka for the opening of Te Rauhina.

Another lot of whānau I didn't mention also was our Tuhura whānau from Napier and our whānau from Taupo, we had a lot of whānau that came from out of town. The rebuild bought a lot of our whānau home from the city. And a lot of them joined the kapa haka which was a great highlight for us because for myself being 12, I didn't know what was going on, we never asked questions, we just did what we did and what we had to do, so if we were asked to sing that waiata, we sang. If we were asked to lead, we led and so for me the very first person I can recall distinctly being at the front teaching was Tania Rātapu, who I can remember as being the very first person I met at Kihitu and she was supported by our kuia which was my grandmother Hēni Kamaea, Nanny Paea Pearse, Nanny Maggie Peka, and Nanny Didi Mihaere.

There was also a lot of whānau input. But I do remember Tania Ratapu being out the front. Her mother Tairawhiti Rātapu was also a huge influence to our singing as well. We had Lena Manuel who played a major part in our whānau. But all in all, our kapa haka was formed by family who had whakapapa links to Te Rauhina.

What are some of your fondest memories of that time?

One of my fondest memories of that time during the rebuild and for kapa haka itself was the whakapapa of how everyone was related because kapa haka united us all and although we may not have known one another at first, by the end of our kapa haka journey, kapa haka brings whakapapa, and with that comes whanaungatanga. It brought us all back together. That was one of my fondest memories of the rebuild and kapa haka back then.

What can you tell me about Whakarongo ake ki te reo?


Personally, I can't tell you much about the waiata itself. As I said earlier, we just sang the songs that were presented to us in preparation for the whakatuwheratanga. From what I understand, a lot of the waiata were composed by our own whānau from Te Rauhina so a whānau member of te whānau Ānaru Ānaru and Lena Thomas, both were said to have composed this particular waiata. For me it was a beautiful waiata, it was extending that karanga out to the whānau, to all those who came from near and far, it acknowledged the day itself, recognized those who were there from all walks of life, and all waka present on that day. Whakapiri mai ngā iwi – it also acknowledged those who have passed on during that time and finished off extending our thanks to all those who came to celebrate with us on that day. Which was huge for us. To me this waiata was a waiata mihi, waiata aroha.

Do you remember the haka Auē nō wai te motokā? What type of waiata is it to you? Who taught it?

It was a haka pōhiri. I remember learning that at Taihoa. It was a haka from Ngati Porou, we were taught by Honor Goldsmith and a Bruce Aranga and whānau.

What can you tell me about Titiro Ki Whakapūnake?

Titiro ki Whakapūnake was written by Johnny or Hone Keefe from Kihitu and to me it acknowledges Whakapūnake itself and how majestic it is and the significance this maunga has to the people of Ngāti Kahungunu. This is a waiata harikoa, waiata mihi again but back then because it was part of the pōhiri it was a waiata to mihi to all the whānau, waka and iwi that had taken time out to come and celebrate through waiata and kapa haka. This waiata may have been written in the mid-seventies. In conclusion kapa haka for me was something new, something I grew to love, it gave me a sense of whakapapa, whanaungatanga and it gave me a sense of belonging, our tipuna kuia she had given us that identity the type of mana wahine she was through kapa haka. At that time, we were a very shy whānau, we weren't out there so kapa haka was new as we knew it. So my experience is that it was a privilege when kai te hoki ngā mahara to be a part of that rā whakahirahira for us as a people, as a whānau and a iwi that kapa haka for Te Rauhina has made us reflect her qualities in performance it's also reflected through our āhuatanga as individuals and for me it certainly is a privilege to be a mokopuna of Te Rauhina and to have been able to represent her for the years that I have done through kapa haka from the beginning right through.

Kia ora, ko Ānaru Rātapu ahau, nō Kihitu ahau. Āe, he Kaahu hoki ahau. I tipu ake ahau i raro i ngā kaahu e rere haere ana i te rangi. Ko Kihitu tētahi wāhi i waho ake i Te Wairoa. Kei te taha rāwhiiti o te taone tata ana ki te moana.

What was the kapa haka like on the marae back in the time Te Rauhina was being built?

I was excited by kapa haka and I wanted it and I loved it. It was my life for at least 20-30 years. My whole family was involved in the kapa haka. My father, mother,

sisters, brothers. My wife, my 4 kids were all involved in kapa haka and learning about ourselves.

Who can you remember was there, and who was out the front teaching?

I used to comeback from Wellington, Honour Goldsmith and Rangi Paku were there at Taihoa teaching and practicing the songs. Te Rauhina was the name of our group.

Rudolph Tuhura (3)¹⁹

Ko te tangata e whai ake nei, me pēnei kē ngā kōrero mōna. Ka moe a Tamihana i a Hiraina ka puta ko Kehu. Ka moe a Taniwha Christie i a Pahemata Pakuku ka puta ko Tangi Apatu. Ka moe a Kehu Tamihana i a Tangi Apatu ka puta ko Pahemata. Ka moe a Pahemata i a Ānaru Ānaru ka puta ko Tairāwhiti. Ka moe a Tairāwhiti i a Watene Tuhura ka puta ko Tāmati (Tom) te mātaamua. Ka moe a Tāmati Tuhura i a Tini Tuhura nee Keefe, ka puta ko Rudolph Tuhura. Ka heke mai tōna ingoa i tōna koroua, heke iho ki tōna matua kēkē, ā, tatu atu rā ki runga i a ia. Ka moe a Rudolph te tuatoru i a Natalia Taurima ka puta ko tā rāua huatahi, ko Irihāpeti Taurima-Tuhura. He mātanga rorohiko te Rudolph nei. Kai EDU Systems Ltd ia e mahi ana. Tell me about who you are and where you come from please. *I am the son of Tāmati Tuhura and Tini Keefe.*

What was kapa haka like on the marae back in the time Te Rauhina was being built?

All I remember about kapa haka was that for Te Rauhina, a lot of nannies singing I remember there were uncles and aunties singing around the table and I remember being forced to play the guitar.

Who can you remember was there, and who was out the front teaching?

I can't remember who was teaching kapa haka out the front then all I can remember is Tairāwhiti and her teaching songs while uncle Mardy was writing for Pipiwharauroa down in Wellington.

What are some of your fondest memories of that time?

My fondest memories of that time is that Wairoa was a bustling community, you didn't go without and everybody got fed. I always remember there was a space invader parlor, and a movie theatre down the parade and that all whānau mixed and mingled.

What can you tell me about **Whakarongo ake ki te reo**?

I can't remember much about whakarongo ake ki te reo I only remember the tune.

Who composed it? Who was present at the time?

Because I didn't know much about Whakarongo ake ki te reo I don't know who actually composed it. I do know there were a lot of Christie's and Thompson's around at the time, my grandmother was singing but that's all I can remember of that time.

What type of waiata is it to you? (a song of welcome, of identity etc)

I can only actually remember the rangi, that's one song I've not had the chance to learn.

What can you tell me about **E te iwi**?

All I can remember about this song was aunty Muppy and aunty Tania singing that song and I remember before the marae was opened having a lot of practices at Taihoa and learning that song.

Who composed it?

Tangiora Mihaere maybe.

What type of waiata is it to you? (a song of welcome, of identity etc)

That type of waiata to me is one that welcomes people, brings people into your space or to the marae.

What can you tell me about **Titiro Ki Whakapūnake**? Who composed it?

All I know is that I remember singing that song as a child on the pae or when we were out with family. I was always led to believe that it was Hone Keefe who wrote it but then I found out that it was actually Johnny Keefe that wrote it at the time I believe he was the guitarist for the kapa haka group back then.

What type of waiata is it to you? (a song of welcome, of identity etc)

It's a waiata that gives me identity and it ties me back to Kahungunu and back to Te Rauhina.

When was **Titiro Ki Whakapūnake** composed?

I don't know the time period as to when it was composed.

Kotahi tana mokopuna, ko Te Āio tana ingoa. Heoi anō, nikā ūna mahara mō ngā waiata me te pā o Te Rauhina.

Tell me about who you are and where you come from please.

Kia ora e te whānau, ko Kelvin Blondie Te Aroha Rohe taku ingoa, Charlie for short. My parents are Hineaka Smith and Hilton Rohe. I was born and raised in Nuhaka, Whakaki and Wairoa. I am the oldest of 5 children. I am married with 3 daughters and I reside in Gisborne.

What was the kapa haka like on the marae back in the time Te Rauhina was being built? Don't judge me on this but I had spoken to Mum she said there was a rōpū

back in the day but Mum was only little, fast track to the 80's and there was us. The whānau came together for the opening and I believe this was the birth of our rōpū.

Who can you remember was there, and who was out the front teaching? As far I can remember there were the Frazy²⁰ Thompson's. The Apatu²¹ Street Thompsons, Jon Ann, Uncle Bill and Aunty Whiti Ratapu with their entourage, The Taite whānau, Uncle Tommy and Aunty Tini with Rudolph and Te Aroha in tow, the Keefe whānau, and Pāpā Ānaru Ānaru and Neuton Lambert. Uncle Richard Wilson and Aunty Mere Wilson nee Thompson with their whānau.

What are some of your fondest memories of that time? I can't give out too much details because some unsolved mysteries back then maybe solved if I talk, however I have awesome memories of this time, this was the first time I met all my whānau and to this day no matter where we are we are still tight and crazy as ever.

What can you tell me about Whakarongo ake te reo? Who composed it? Who was present at the time? What type of waiata is it to you? When was it written?

I can't explain much about this song, back then we were all kids so we were told to just listen and sing the song, and we did. But personally, this song was abit toooooo slow for my liking.

What can you tell me about E te iwi? I remember with this song I learnt I could sing tenor. I can still hear Muppy and Tania hitting those notes.

Who composed it? Tangiora Mihaere

What type of waiata is it to you? This was another slow song, not my cuppa tea.

When was it written? What can you tell me about Titiro Ki Whakapūnake? Who composed it? I had heard that Johnny Keefe, Aunty Tini's grandfather had written this for another marae but ended up with us.

What type of waiata is it to you? Back then this was one of the groovy songs.

When was Titiro Ki Whakapūnake composed? I don't know sorry.

Te Whiti Tuatahi




